

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:

# The Good Samaritan Law protects you when you seek help during an overdose in Oregon.

If someone is overdosing and you call for help, **you and the person experiencing an overdose** are protected from certain legal consequences in Oregon.



**You're protected** from being arrested or charged for:

- ✓ **Having drugs or drug-use supplies, like syringes or pipes**
- ✓ **Being in a place where drugs are used**
- ✓ **Violating probation or parole because of the overdose**



**You're not protected** from being arrested or charged for:

- ✗ **Drug dealing or selling**
- ✗ **DUI or driving under the influence**
- ✗ **Weapon charges**
- ✗ **Federal or out-of-state warrants, including immigration**
