The Good Samaritan Law protects you when you seek help during an overdose in Oregon.

If someone is overdosing and you call for help, **you and the person experiencing an overdose** are protected from certain legal consequences in Oregon.



You're protected from being arrested or charged for:

- Having drugs or drug-use supplies, like syringes or pipes
- ✓ Being in a place where drugs are used
- ✓ Violating probation or parole because of the overdose



You're not protected from being arrested or charged for:

- X Drug dealing or selling
- **X** DUII or driving under the influence
- × Weapon charges
- Federal or out-of-state warrants, including immigration
