Tools & Materials

Share guides, instructions and educational resources to help partners deliver life-saving information in their communities.

Supplies

Distribute state-funded naloxone and other supplies free of charge to organizations that meet eligibility criteria.

Training & Education

Host Learning Collaboratives and provide support to organizations seeking to integrate life-saving strategies into their services.

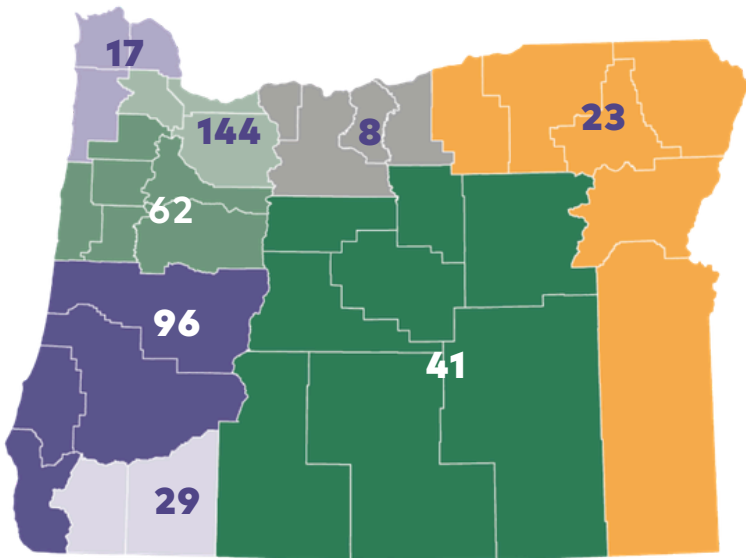

420 PARTNERS IN OREGON

- 46%** are community organizations
- 25%** are first responders (fire, police, sheriff, EMS)
- 9%** are substance use treatment facilities

Partners serve communities most impacted by overdose. Communities receiving specialized support include unhoused or housing-insecure individuals, rural Oregonians, young adults, LGBTQIA+ people, and Black, Indigenous and other people of color.

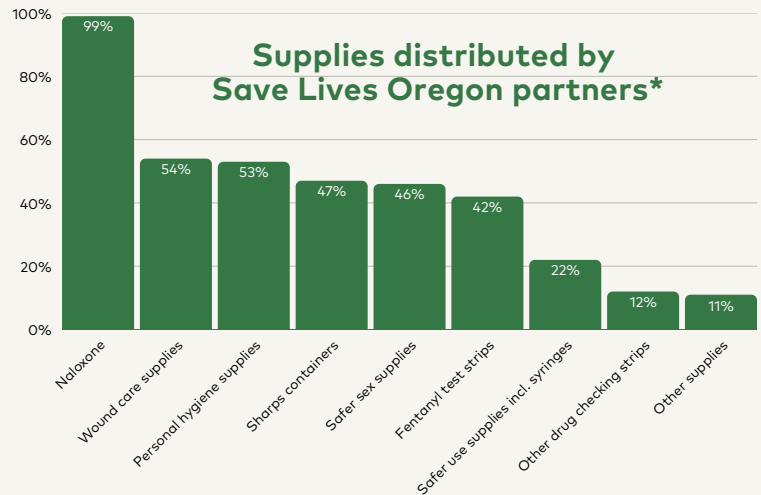

SUPPLIES DISTRIBUTED

Widespread naloxone distribution is proven to slow the growth of opioid overdose death rates

- 99%** of partners distribute naloxone to communities across the state
- ~60%** of partners say Save Lives Oregon is their only source for supplies*
